The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received a loan from the OPEC Fund for International Development (OFID) towards the cost of Rehabilitation of the A017 Road Corridor Project (Suriyakanda – Rakwana) carried out by the Miscellaneous Foreign Aided Projects (MFAP) Division. This loan will be used for payments under the contracts named above.
2. The Road Development Authority (“the Employer”) now invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the Rehabilitation of the A017 Road Corridor Project (Suriyakanda – Rakwana) section from Ch. 112+600km to Ch. 130+600km as detailed below.

The International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding Procedure.

3. Eligible bidders must meet the following general & specific criteria:
 - (i) Pending Litigation shall not represent more than 50% of the bidder’s net worth
 - (ii) The bidders net worth within last 5 years shall be positive
 - (iii) General experience in construction contracts within last five years
 - (iv) Average annual construction turnover (AACT) within last 5 years, financial resources, and specific construction experience within last 5 yrs as given in the table below.

- (v) Personnel: the bidder must demonstrate that he has the personnel for the following key positions for this project: (i) 1 Project Manager (Professionally Qualified BSc Civil Engineer with 10 years total & minimum 5 years experience in similar work); (ii) 1 Site Engineer (BSc Civil Engineer with 8 years total & minimum 4 years experience in similar works); (III). 1 Quality Assurance Manager (BSc Engineering or Equivalent with 8 years total & minimum 3 years experience in similar works);
- (vi) Equipment: The Bidder must demonstrate the availability of key equipment listed bellow through presentation of proof of ownership or proof of intention to lease or rent with a provision that the equipment will remain on site as per the contract.
