Followi	ng points were discussed in the meeting,			
1	Mr. Deepthi Lokuarachchi (GCEO) explained that the scope of this tender should be as Design, Installation, Implementation, commissioning and Maintenance of the System including development of operational acceptance testing and system integration with third party solutions and connectivity to existing resources.			
2	<b>Data Migration:</b> Data migration will be arranged by the LHC in collaboration with our current supplier. This includes a data migration component that must transfer administrative data, such as patient demographic data, master data, and all other opening balances, including inventory and outstanding amounts. It does not involve migrating the entire database.			
3	<b>Incumbent Vendors:</b> This is a completely new project, and incumbent vendors are not part of this project.			
4	<b>Third party authorization / registration:</b> Third party applications to be integrated with the HIS system. Eg. Insurance and Admission			
5	<b>Branches which are covered under this HIS:</b> This project covers the hospital. Does not include the laboratories. Laboratories have separate systems and only integration part have to be done.			
6	Double Occupancy: Explained about the two scenarios. In one instance - Sometimes patients go for the Sometimes, patients go to the OT and are temporarily placed in another bed (e.g., ICU). Both the ICU bed and the patient room are detained, and the patient is charged for both.  In another scenario, patients' attendants are assigned to one room and use the facilities, but the patient is in another room. Consequently, both rooms are charged			

7	The same patient admission number or visit number will remain until the patient is discharged.  UHID is unique for every patient				
8	Integration with the other systems: Only application integration needs to be done, not machine integration. The Laboratory Information System (LIS) is currently running. We only need the integration part of the LIS with the HIS, along with integration with SAP B1, the channeling system, and other small systems we use. All GRNs and POs will be raised under SAP, and all the sub stores are in the HIS and need to be integrated. This new HIS system must also have the ability to integrate with future requirements.				
9	Other system requirements: Linen Management – Current we don't have but need this system				
	CSSD – Currently we have software that needs to be integrated.				
	Telemedicine transfer patient data				
	Homecare application – Basically need to screen whatever the patient.				
	Business continuity plan and DR (Disaster recovery): in case of system

PACS is not needed for this system at present, and no PACS viewer is required. However, the system should have the capability to integrate with PACS if it becomes available in the future. After PACS is implemented, a PACS viewer will be necessary.				
11	Development tools –BI tools / Supplier can decide and come to conclusions before development.				
	System should be agile.				
12	We prefer an On-promise system.				
13	<b>Expected Applications:</b> We are expecting mobile app and mobile version, and we mentioned it in our RFP.				
14	Security: We are expecting HIPA compliance. Firewall security levels managed by LH. Other application-				
	level security must give by the supplier.				
15	<b>User Login:</b> existing No of users 500No's (concurrent). we expect unlimited user login.				
16	Website revamping is already done it is in progress. It's not part of this project				
17	Pricing: Pricing only for software. Not infrastructure. According to the RFP				
18	<b>10.4.2: Maintenance:</b> A separate Service Level Agreement will be entered into by and between the Hospital and the Service Provider within thirty (30) days from the Operational Acceptance Test (OAT) for the purpose of maintenance of the product/software/ hardware/ Hospital Information System.				
19	<b>Lead time &amp; AMC:</b> 1 year. AMC 1 <sup>st</sup> two years FOC and 2 <sup>nd</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> Year only charging				
20	Agreement: Escrow agreement mange by the LHC.				
21	Language: English / No need local language requirements.				
22	Dashboard: Dashboard should be able to integrate in the power BI.				
23	Suppliers do not need to provide hardware or any consumables. Must provide only software. Sometimes
